## Garnant Park Junior/Youth Membership.

- 1. General
  - a. A Junior/Youth member shall be entitled to play on any day subject to certain constraints imposed by the Committee whenever a full member's competition is being played.
  - b. A Junior/Youth member is not entitled to attend meetings, vote at the AGM, or take part in the management of the Club.
  - c. A Junior/Youth member is entitled to make full use of the Clubhouse and its facilities. N.B. Dress rules, including footwear always apply.
  - d. A Junior/Youth member is entitled to use the practice areas at any time the course is open to full members.
  - e. A Junior/Youth member is entitled to introduce visitors at a reduced fee. Any one visitor is only entitled to play 6 times in any one calendar year at the reduced rate.
  - f. Fees and subscriptions will be reviewed at the AGM. Payment methods will be the same for all categories of membership.
  - g. Youth members are defined as a person who is aged 16-17 and have left compulsory education. They are permitted to enter all adult club competitions.
- 2. Competitions
  - a. Specific junior competitions are normally played on Sundays.
  - b. When entering competitions youth/junior members must have a good understanding and knowledge of the rules of golf.
  - c. In line with competition rules the members must have the ability to mark their own/opponents playing card
  - d. Members must have the ability to independently take their own bag/equipment through 9/18 holes depending on the competition.
  - e. Junior/Youth members may enter club competitions under the following rules:
    - Any Junior playing in a Club competition must play with an adult member.
      This does not apply to Youth members.
    - ii. When entering Board competitions a maximum handicap of 24 for male, and a maximum handicap of 36 for female entrants will be applied.
    - iii. Juniors in school years 7-11 are permitted to enter adult club competitions, but they must play with a consenting adult member. This will need to be prearranged and booked on BRS system at least 24hrs in advance where possible.
    - iv. Juniors may be selected to represent the Club in outside competitions where rules permit.
- 3. Notes
  - a. Every category of member is subject to the same disciplinary procedures as laid down in the Articles of Association.
  - b. The Executive Committee reserves the right to review all these terms and conditions as required.
